Why not leave the car behind and use the bus or train whilst here. You can see so much of Cornwall from a **bus**, open top buses run on some coastal routes.

Try the **Falmouth to Truro Maritime line**. **St Ives** is a lovely place with very narrow streets and limited parking, so why not go by train. Further afield the **Looe branch line** is a beautiful journey.

We are very close to the tramways cycle trail – bikes can be hired at **Bissoe**.
